3 NIGHTS 4 DAYS SALT PAN SAFARI TRIP



Experience this fun filled tour to Lekhubu Island and Makgadikgadi Pans National Park. Tented camping, bush showers and mobile toilets will be provided. All meals will be offered. Our safaris are simple yet comfortable and all your needs will be catered for.

DAY 1-Lekhubu Island



On the first day of this, clients will be picked where they are lodged by our professional guide depart to Lekhubu Island. Kubu Island is a rock out crop which was submerged in the water of the great Lake Makgadikgadi which was one of the largest lakes in Africa. Kubu is a Setswana name for a hippopotamus while Lekhubu means a rock outcrop.

About 10 000 years ago the Lake Makgadikgadi dried up and Lekhubu was left an island surrounded by miles and miles of white salt. Research indicates that climatic changes and earth movements over thousands and thousands of years caused this dramatic change to take place. Low rock walls on the southern side of Lekhubu Island dates back to the great Zimbabwean empire.

Packed lunch will be served along the way. Upon arrival, clients will be taken for a game drive and later arrive.

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DAY 2




Wake up call at 06:00am, clients will be offered hot water from the fire for showering and breakfast will be ready at 06:30am.

After breakfast there will be a guided walk to rocks. Lekhubu is located in the Southern campus of the large natural topographic depression within the Makgadikgadi region of Botswana called the Sua pan, which is the largest pan in Botswana. Lekhubu site is off the track in between the Gweta village, Nata and Letlhakane, therefore people who visit the site are encouraged to be in touch with the villagers to get more information on how to get there or visit the Mmatshumo village and the veterinary gates. Mmatshumo is just 42km away from Lekhubu and roughly 100km away from Gweta village at their full set campsite. Time for bed will be determined by the client.

Arrive back at the campsite for full brunch before exiting the park to Makgadikgadi Pans National Park.

DAY 3-Makgadikgadi Pans National Park



There will be a morning game drive. Makgadikgadi Pans National Park is one of the largest flat salt pans in the world. During the wet season (November to March), wildlife viewing is excellent, particularly when large herds of zebra and wildebeest begin their westward migration to the Boteti region. Species include gemsbok, eland and red hartebeest, as well as kudu, bushbuck, duiker, giraffe, springbok, steenbok, and even elephant, with all the accompanying predators, as well as the rare brown hyena. Clients will get to spend only 1 night here. Upon arrival, clients will have a chance to do the game drive before they get to their full set campsite. Dinner will be served in the evening and time for bed will be determined by the clients.

On the last day of the trip, clients will get a chance to a game drive early in the morning before exiting the park. Packed lunch will be brought along.
